CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE 14 DAYS

1st Day – Friday PRAGUE

Arrival, assistance and transfer to hotel. Accommodation.



2nd Day – Saturday PRAGUE

Breakfast and accommodation. Panoramic tour around the city, visiting some of the more relevant buildings and monuments in the monumental area of the castle, where one can visit St. Vitus Cathedral, built in gothic style, and the picturesque Golden alley where, it seem to be, King Rudolf II's courtiers lived (tickets not included).

3rd Day – Sunday PRAGUE – VIENNA

Breakfast and departure to Vienna. Arrival and accommodation. Free evening.

4th Day – Monday VIENNA

Breakfast and accommodation. Panoramic tour to the city going round the "Ringstrasse" where you can find the most typical buildings and monuments in the city, such as the State Opera House, Hofburg Palace, Art-history Museum, the Parliament, Monuments devoted to Mozart or Goethe, City Hall, etc. **OPTIONAL:** lunch or dinner at a typical restaurant with live music. Free evening.



5th Day – Tuesday VIENNA – BUDAPEST

Breakfast and departure to Budapest. Arrival at noon. Panoramic tour around the city. We will start visiting Buda Castle hill to see the Danube River and gaze at the whole area of Pest. Transfer to hotel. Accommodation. **OPTIONAL:** Hungarian Night with a show. Dinner with a *czarda* and boat trip.

6th Day – Wednesday BUDAPEST

Breakfast and free morning. Evening, optional visit to Godoy Palace, which dates back to 18th century. Transfer to hotel and accommodation.



7th Day – Thursday BUDAPEST – EGER

Breakfast and departure to Eger, 130 km away from Budapest, direction to Romania. Rich city with Baroque buildings and very well-known by its wine called "bull's blood". Transfer to Hotel and accommodation. Free evening. **OPTIONAL:** Lunch at a typical restaurant.

8th Day – Friday EGER – MARIAPOCS – DEBRECEN

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Mariapocs, pilgrimage site in Hungary due to the famous Crying Virgin picture which John Paul II visited in 1991. Free lunch. We will go on our journey to Debrece, the second largest city in Hungary, which is called the "Calvinists' Rome". It have big hotels with thermal springs. Accommodation in hotel. **OPTIONAL:** Lunch or dinner at a typical restaurant. We are just 60 km away from Romania border.



9th Day – Saturday DEBRECEN – ARAD

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to the border. Arrival in Romania and journey to Arad. Arrival and tour around the city: Cultural Palace, Serbian Church raised in 18th century, Old and New Theatre building. **OPTIONAL:** Lunch or dinner at a typical restaurant. Accommodation in hotel.

10th Day – Sunday ARAD – SIBIU

Breakfast at the hotel. We will go on with our circuit. Arrival in Sibiu, founded by Saxon colonists, with its Evangelic and Orthodox cathedrals. Accommodation. **OPTIONAL:** Lunch or dinner at a typical restaurant.



11th Day – Monday SIBIU – BRAŞOV

Breakfast and departure to Braşov, one of the most beautiful medieval cities in Transylvania. We will cross through Sighişoara, one of the most ancient medieval cities in Europe, and which has been declared World Heritage Site by the UNESCO. In the evening, tour around the medieval centre in Braşov. Accommodation. **OPTIONAL:** Lunch or dinner at a typical restaurant

12th Day – Tuesday BRAŞOV – BUCHAREST

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Bucharest. Stop and tour around Sinaia, the "Carpathian Pearl", Romanian kings' summer dwelling place, with its wonderful Peleş Castle. Arrival in Bucharest and tour around the city, with its Parliament, the Patriarchy, the Royal Palace, etc. Accommodation. **OPTIONAL:** Lunch or dinner at a restaurant



13th Day – Wednesday BUCHAREST

Breakfast at the hotel and visit to the Palace of Parliament, built by Ceauşescu, which is the second largest building in the world, after the Pentagon. Free evening. Optional tours at request. Accomodation in hotel. **OPTIONAL:** Lunch or dinner at a restaurant

14th Day – Thursday BUCHAREST

Breakfast and Transfer to the airport. End of our services.
