

1st Day – Friday WARSAW - CRACOW

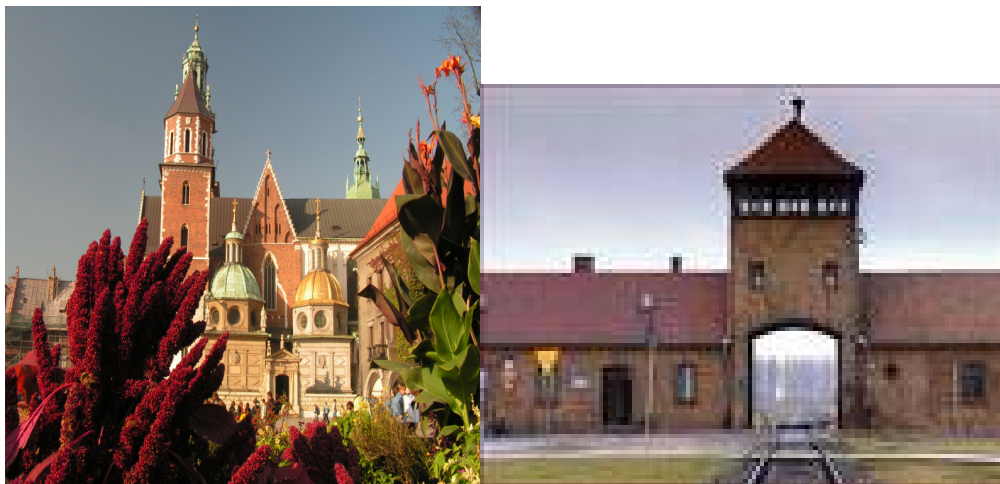
Arrival in Cracow. Accommodation in the hotel. First night in Cracow. (The tour can be started from Warsaw or another city, depending on the flights).

**2nd Day – Saturday CRACOW**

Breakfast at the hotel. Tour around Cracow: the limestone hill, the site of the Royal Castle and the cathedral (place where Polish kings were crowned and where they are buried). Old Town (*Stare Miasto*) where one can visit the oldest market in Europe, St. Mary's Church (or *Kościół Mariacki*). Stroll around the Old Town and visit to a shop which shows a multimedia presentation about the history of amber, the Polish gold. Departure to Wieliczka to visit the Salt mine, which entered into the original UNESCO roster of World Heritage Sites; The salt mine forms an "underground town" with churches, lakes and passages, digged in the salt by the Polish miners for the centuries of its existence. **OPTIONAL:** Dinner and traditional Jewish music concert at Kazimierz, Jewish quarter.

3rd Day – Sunday CRACOW – AUSCHWITZ – CRACOW

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Auschwitz and visit to the former concentration camp where more than a million people were killed during the Second World War, most of them Jewish. Return to Cracow. Free time in Cracow.

**4th Day – Monday CRACOW – ŁAGIEWNIKI – WADOWICE – WROCŁAW**

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Łagiewniki and visit to the Shrine of Divine Mercy, where you can see the image of The Divine Mercy and St. Faustina Kowalska's tomb. We will continue our journey to Wadowice, the birthplace of Pope John Paul II, where we will visit the Holy Father Family House and the parochial church where he was christened. Departure to Wrocław. Accommodation in the hotel.



5th Day – Tuesday **WROCLAW**

Breakfast at the hotel. Stroll around Wrocław's Old Market. Visit to the Gothic Municipal Palace, the university and Ostrów Tumski ("Cathedral Island"). Free time in Wrocław.

6th Day – Wednesday **WROCLAW – CZĘSTOCHOWA - WARSAW**

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Częstochowa. Visit to the Paulite monastery of Jasna Góra, which is the home of the Black Madonna painting, the most important pilgrimage site in Poland. We will go on our journey to Warsaw. Arrival in Warsaw.



7th Day – Thursday **WARSAW**

Breakfast at the hotel. Łazienkowski Park, the Palace of Culture and Science, Krakowskie Przedmieście Street, the former Warsaw Ghetto, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Old Town quarter, where it is located the Royal Castle, St. John's Cathedral, the Market square. Free time in Warsaw. **OPTIONAL:** Dinner and concert of Chopin's music at a restaurant.

8th Day – Friday **WARSAW**

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport. End of our services.
